Do you collect coins? Would you like to learn more about coin collecting? Do you want to find out which coins in your pocket could be worth thousands of dollars?

The BNA is a member of The *American Numismatic Association* which is the national sponsor of the Boy Scout "Coin Collecting Merit Badge". Mr. James Bucki, professional educator, numismatic researcher and writer will deliver this informative and entertaining workshop.

Each scout attending in uniform will receive brochures, bookmarks, and other material from the U.S. Mint. In addition, they will also receive coins, books, and other items to add to their collections.

Not a Boy Scout? **Cub Scouts, siblings, friends and Girl Scouts are welcome too!** Just pre-register and be accompanied by your parent or adult partner.

Prerequisites (Required for all Boy Scouts)

The following requirements must be completed and brought with you to the workshop. Please refer to the Requirements in the *Coin Collecting Merit Badge Handbook* for more detail.

- **BOY SCOUTS:** Read the entire Coin Collecting Merit Badge Pamphlet (Yes! The whole thing!)
 - 6) Describe the 1999-2008 50 State Quarters Program or the 2010-2021 America the Beautiful Quarters®. Collect and show your counselor five different quarters you have acquired from circulation.
 - 7) Collect from circulation a set of currently circulating U.S. coins. Include one coin of each denomination (cent, nickel, dime, quarter, half-dollar, dollar). For each coin, locate the mint marks, if any, and the designer's initials, if any.
 - 9d) Collect a set of a single type of coin since the year of your birth. For example; if you were born in 1996, collect one penny from 1996, one from 1997, one from 1998, etc.

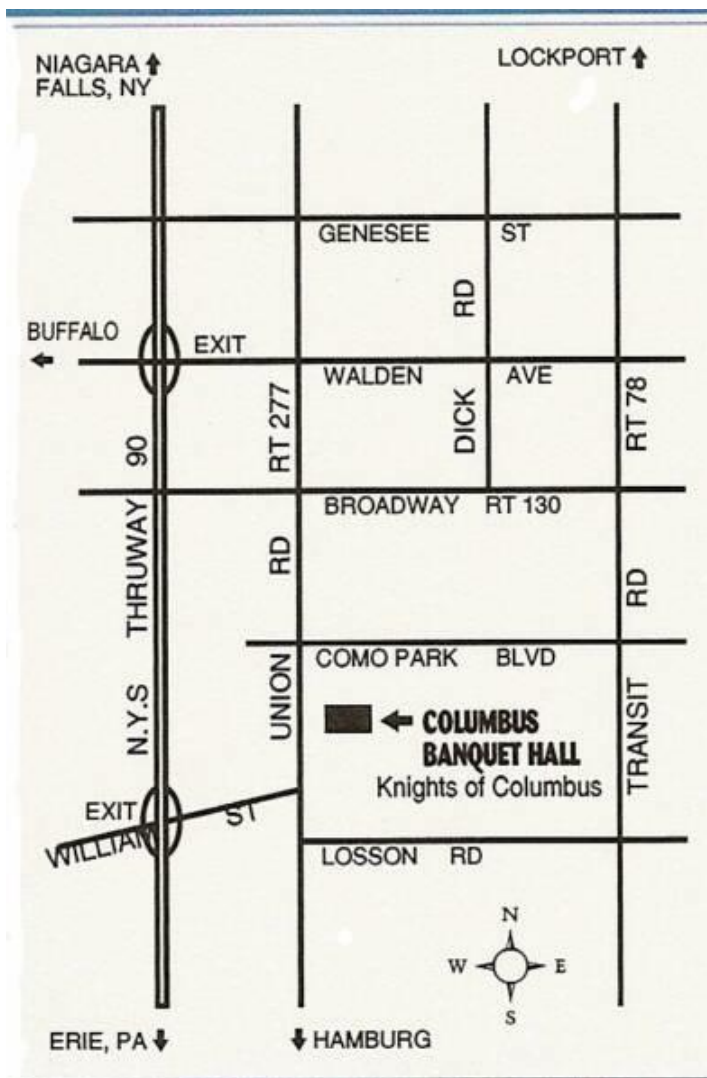
